

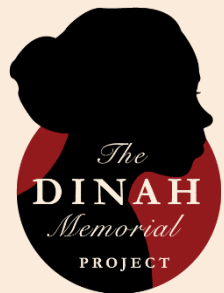

Completed 1730







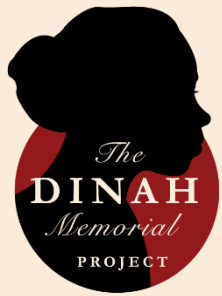


# Inequality in Bronze: The Big Ideas

- Elevate and commemorate Dinah's **full story and humanity**
- Address the **national debate about monuments** and the absence of memorials to millions of enslaved Africans and Africans Americans, whose contributions to our history remain ignored or silenced in many public spaces



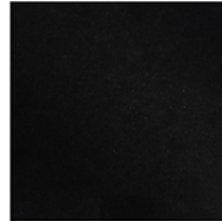

## **ENGRAVED LETTERS:**

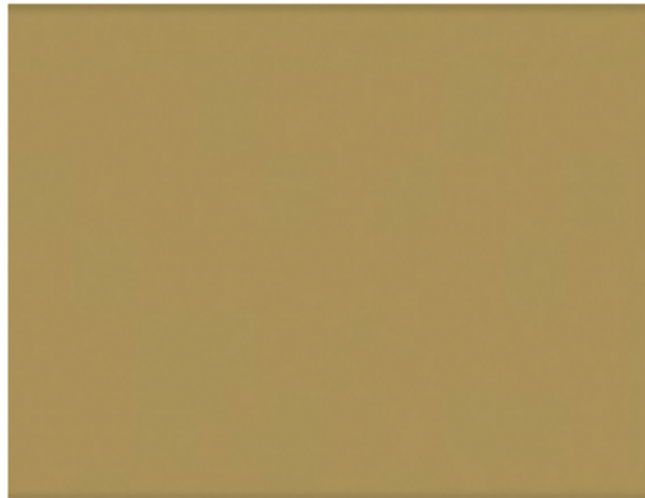
**Lithichrome Stone Paint—**

**Premium paint used on granite monuments and other stones.**

**Good bonding and weatherproofing capabilities.**

**May need to be renewed in 20 years.**

**Bronze with matte finish**





## **Fountain Maintenance**

**(The fountain will be turned off during cold weather months)**

- Clean leaves and debris from fountain bowl regularly as required**
- Clean filter basket weekly**
- Fill chlorinator with 2 tablets monthly**
- Clean cartridge filter every 2 months**

### **Fall shut down**

- Drain, install plugs, blow out lines with shop vacuum, remove cartridge filter and clean.**
- Turn off water and power, blow out auto fill line.**

### **Spring start up**

- Remove plugs, fill with water, add chlorine**

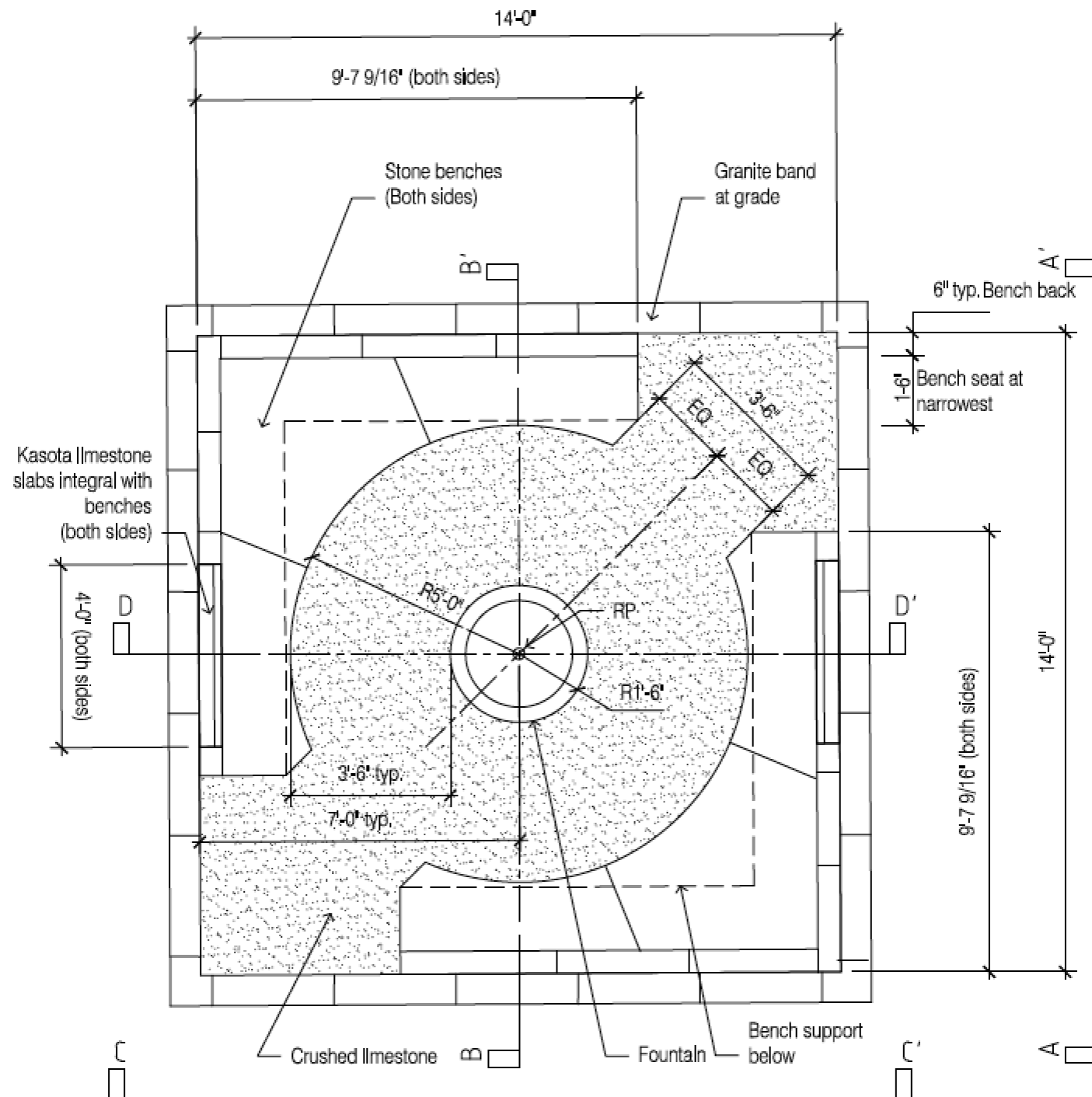

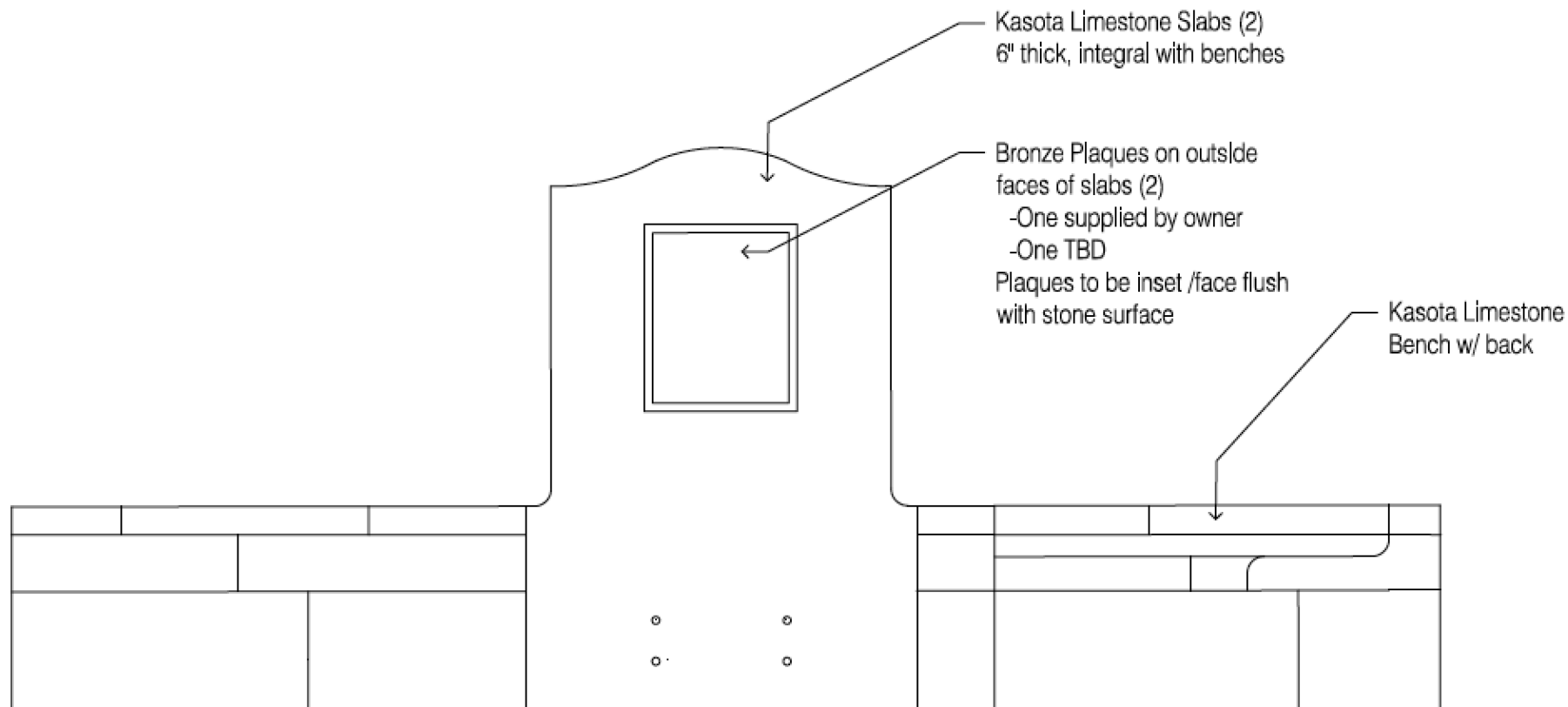








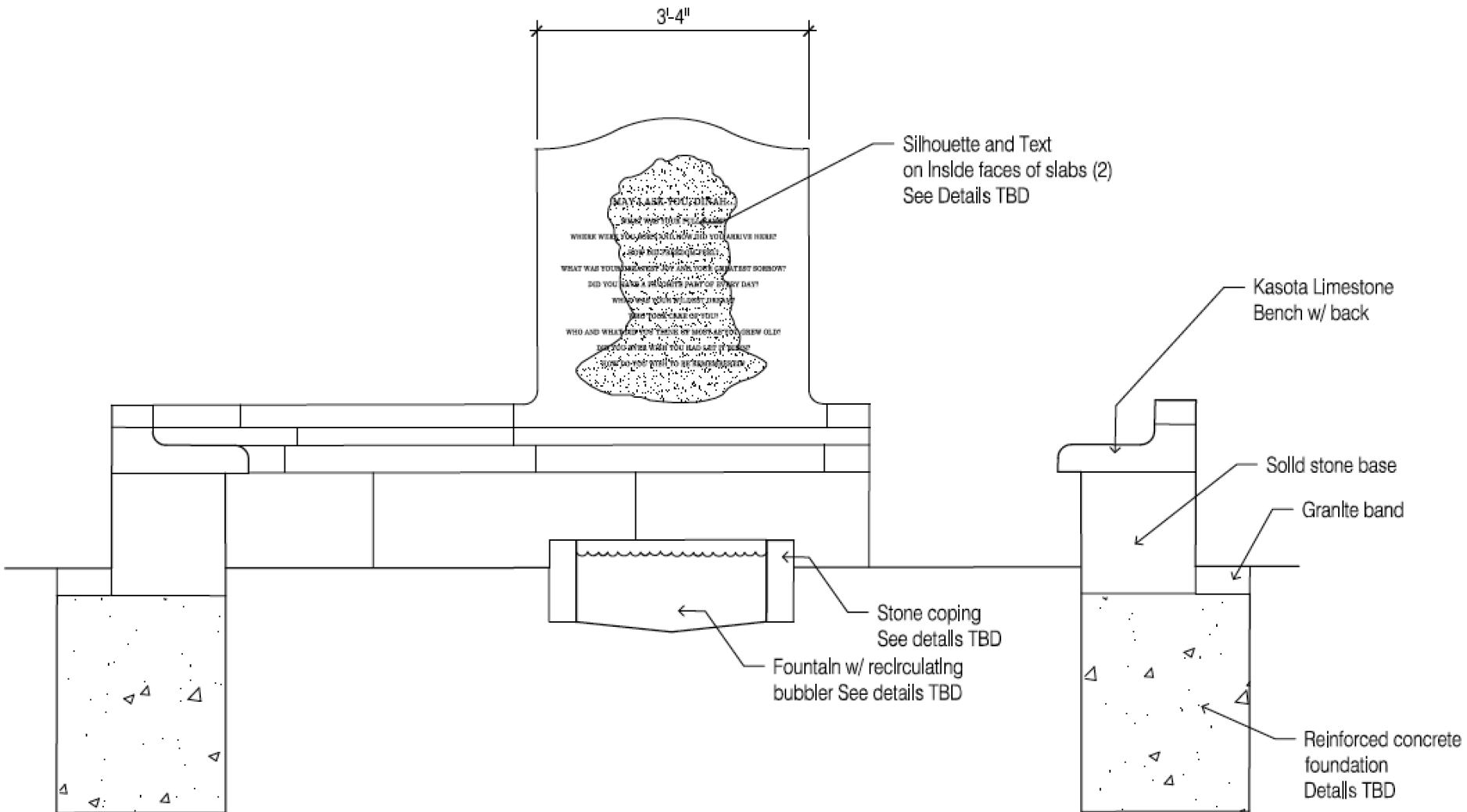




Elevation A - A' - Exterior Elevation at Entry

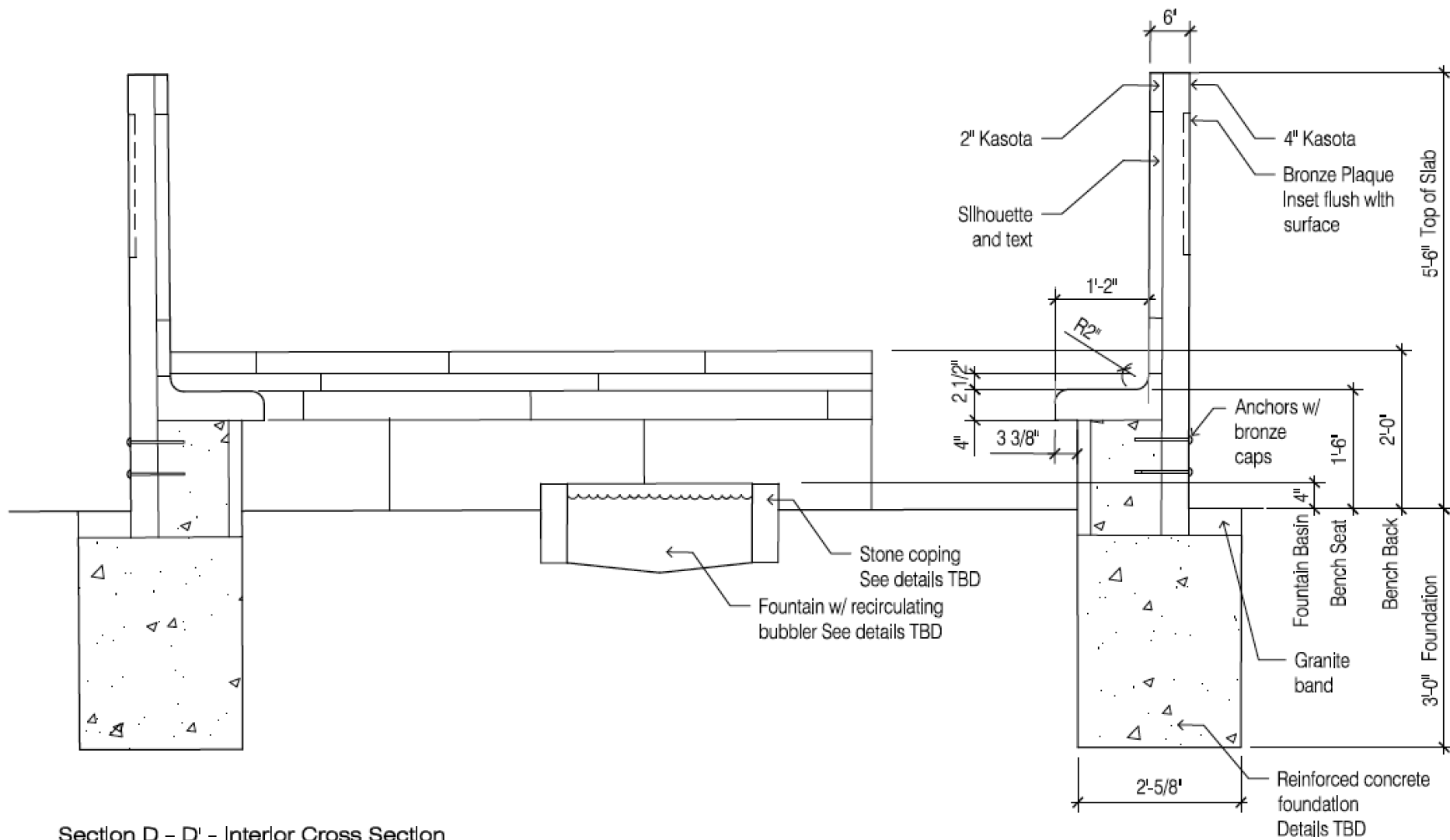

Section B - B' - Interior Cross Section Showing Slabs

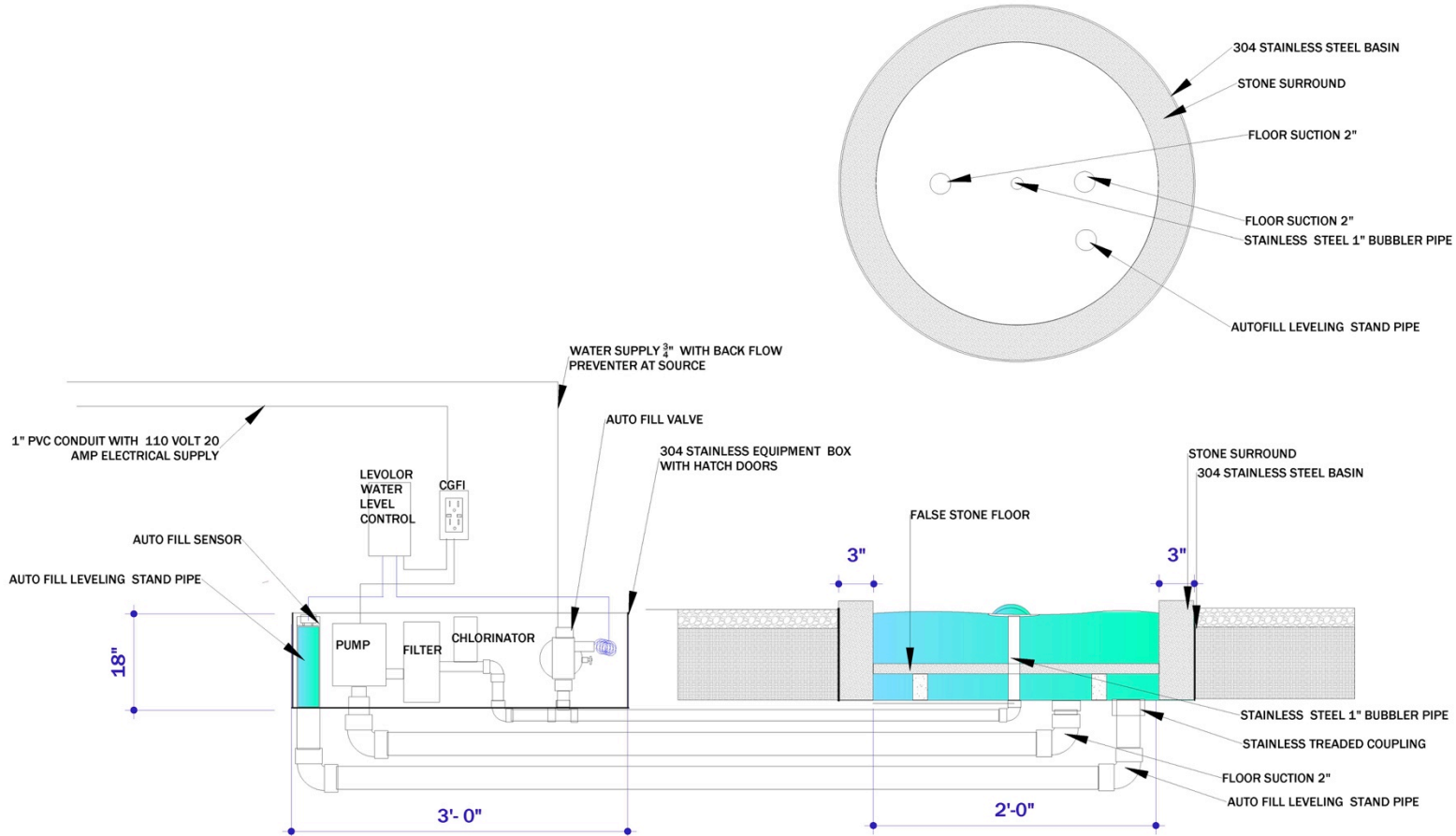
